

# Why did Jesus Die?



## 1. Because we are all sinners!

Marka 2:17 Jesuh nih a theih hna i, “A dammi nih cun sibawi an herh ÷ung lo, a zawmi lawng nih pei an herh ko cu; miding mi hna kawh awkah ka ra lo, misual mi hna kawh awk tu ah ka ra,” tiah a ti hna.

Rom Caluat 3:10 Cathiang nih, “A dingmi ahohmanh an um lo,

Matthai 18:11 Mi Fapa cu a tlaumi khamh awkah ka ra.

## 2. Because there is a cost for that sin!

Mattathi 15:18-20 Sihmanhsehlaw kaa chungin a chuakmi thil cu lung chungin a chuakmi thil an si i cu hna nih cun mi cu an thurter. Zeicahtiah lai a nawntertu, nu le pa sualnak a tuahtertu, thil ÷halo dangdang a tuahtertu, a firtertu, lih a chimtertu, mi a congoihtertu ruahnak ÷halo vialte cu a lung chungin a hung chuakmi an si. Hihi mi a thurtertu cu an si. Sihmanhsehlaw rawl ei lai kut ÷awl lo nih cun mi a thurter lo,” tiah a ti.

Rom Caluat 6:23 Zeicahtiah sualnak man cu thihnak a si, sihmanhsehlaw Pathian laksawng cu zungzal nunnak a si i cu nunnak cu kan Bawipa Jesuh Khrih he aa pehtlaimi nunnak a si.

Marka 16:16 A zum i tipilnak a ingmi paoh nih khamhnak an hmuh lai, a zum lomi paoh nih sual phawtnak an hmuh lai.



**There is a cost for sin!**

### **3. Because Jesus died and paid for our sins on the cross!**

Mattathi 1:21 Fapa a hrin lai i a min ah Jesuh na sak lai — zeicahtiah a mi kha an sualnak chungin a khamh hna lai,” tiah a ti.

Rom Caluat 5:8 Asinain Pathian nih cun zeitluk in dah a kan dawt kha hitihin a langhter: kannih cu misual kan si ko rih lioah hin Khrih cu kan caah a thi

Johan 3:16 Cuticun Pathian nih vawlei hi a dawt hringhran caah a Fapa ngeihchunte kha a pek, cucaah amah a zummi paoh cu an thi lai lo, zungzal nunnak an ngei lai.

Matthai 18:11 Mi Fapa cu a tlaumi khamh awkah ka ra.

### **4. Salvation is a free gift, not by good works. You must take God’s word for it, and trust Jesus alone!**

Lamkaltu 4:12 Amah thawng lawnglawng in khamhnak hi hmuh khawh a si. Zeicahtiah vawlei cung dihlak ah hin a kan khamh khotu ding min dang zehmanh a um lo,” tiah a ti.

Efesa 2:8-9 8Nannih cu vel an ngeih hna caah an khamh hna i khamhnak nan hmuh cu amah nan zumhnak thawngin a si. Khamhnak nan hmuhmi cu nanmah tuahmi a si lo, Pathian laksawng a si. 9Hi kongah hin nan i porhlawt khawhmi zehmanh a um lo, zeicahtiah nanmah tuannak thawngin nan hmuhmi a si lo.

Titas 3:5 cu a kan khamhnak cu hrinthannak ti thawng le Thiang Thlarau nih mi tharter khawhnak a ngeihmi thawnnak thawngin a si.

### **5. We must put our faith and trust in Christ alone!**

Marka 9:23 Jesuh nih, “Na kan bawmh khawh ahcun na ti maw? Asi, zumhnak a ngeimi caah cun ze paoh a si kho ko,” tiah a ti.

Marka 1:15 "A caan kha a phan cang. Pathian Pennak cu a phan dengmang cang. Nan sualnak kha kaltak hna u law Thawngtha kha zum tuah u," tiah a ti hna.

Marka 10:15 Mah hi philh hlah u. Pathian Pennak kha ngakchia nih an cohlan bantukin a cohlang lomi cu, ahohmanh Pathian Pennak chungah cun an lut lai lo," tiah a ti.

Rom Caluat 10:9-10,13 Nan kaa in, "Jesuh cu Bawipa a si," tiah nan ti i "amah cu Pathian nih mithi hna sinin a thawhter" tiah nan lung in nan zumh ahcun, khamh nan si lai. Zeicahtiah kan lung in kan zumh i Pathian he i remnak kan hmuh; kan kaa in kan chim i khamh kan si. 3Cathiang nih, "Bawipa min a aumi paoh cu khamh an si lai," a ti bangin a si taktak ko.
